HOW TO MEASURE KIDS' FEET

- 1 Make sure your printout size chart is accurate by placing a credit card in the outline below.
- 2 Cut the size chart at the dotted line and place it on the floor against the wall.
- 3 Have your kid stand on the size chart with their heel against the wall and measure their right foot. Then, measure their left foot.
- 4 Record your kid's measurements with a pencil in the below chart.

PRO TIPS

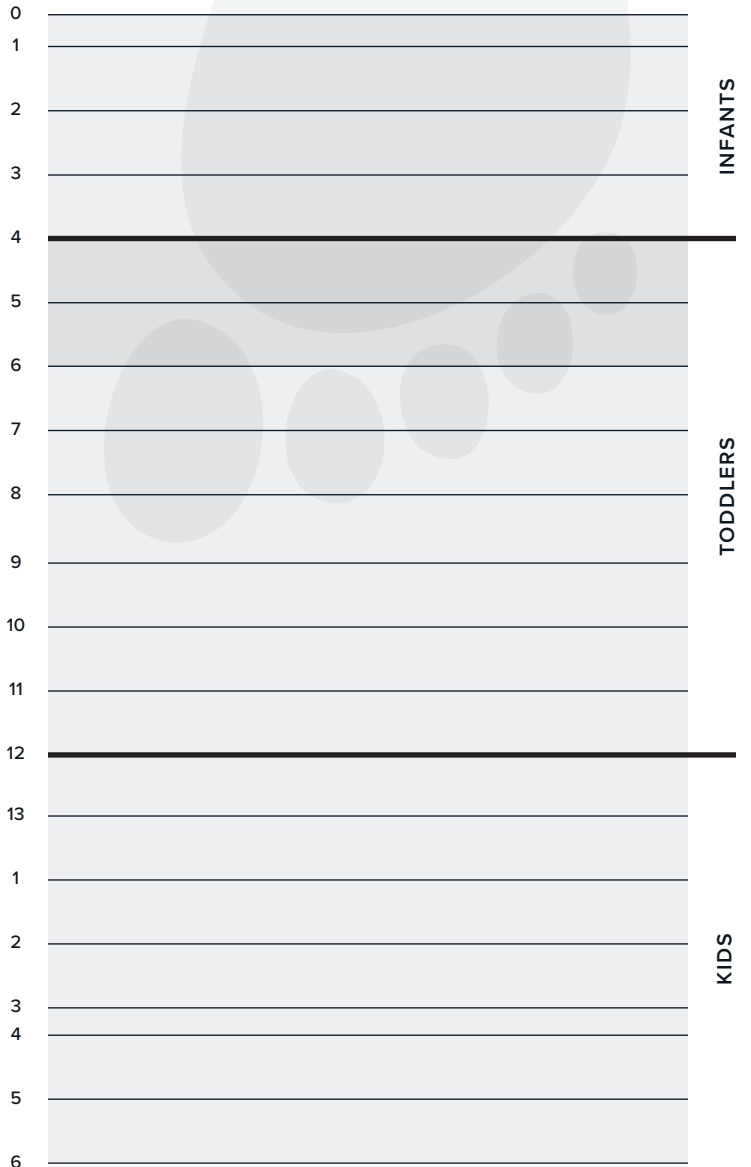
If your kid's feet are different sizes, choose the larger size.

If your kid's feet fall between two sizes, go a size up.

Only measure the length. Don't measure the width.

A kid's foot can grow up a half size every three months, so be sure to re-measure every two months.
